Foundations Requirement: 12 hours of graduate coursework comprising (i) any BEF or BEP classes or (ii) any other non-research method courses outside of the student's department. Approved by the program of study committee, these classes are intended to introduce the theoretical discourses and bodies of knowledge that provide a depth and breadth of understanding necessary for fluency with research, theory, and scholarship foundational to the student's field of inquiry and dissertation research.

**GRADUATE SCHOOL Ed. D. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS**

- Minimum of 60 semester hours of course credit beyond the Master's degree or minimum of 90 Semester hours of course credit at the graduate level
- Minimum of 12 semester hours of dissertation research credit. If approved, 6 semester hours of Dissertation may be included in the minimum 60 or 90 semester hour program of study
- Time limits: 6 years before admission; 7 years after admission
- Transfer rule: up to one-half of course credit (not to include dissertation research credit)

Ed. D. program planning committees consist of a minimum of three members, one of whom Must be from outside the program in which the student is enrolled.
