#### Notes:

1. We strongly recommend that General Studies courses be scheduled in the morning to avoid conflicts with ensembles.
2. \*Students have received information from the Music Theory Area about their Music Theory placement.
3. \*\* For Principal Applied, students should register for their major instrument and take the class for 2 hours (the class is offered for variable credit).
4. \*\*\* Students will register for section 001 of Huxford Symphony Orchestra or Symphonic Band. If a student is taking optional Marching Band then enroll in section 002 of Symphony Orchestra or Symphonic Band for 0 hours. Ensemble auditions will occur prior to the first day of classes.
5. \*\*\*\* Take EN 102 if student has EN 101. If qualified for EN 103, take it instead, otherwise USE DEGREE WORKS TO SELECT ANOTHER GENERAL STUDIES COURSE
6. \*\*\*\*\* If student has AP Psychology credit, take HD 101 or USE DEGREE WORKS TO SELECT ANOTHER GENERAL STUDIES COURSE
7. \*\*\*\*\* MATH 110 or above is required to satisfy the Math general studies requirement.
