Eligibility

- A. Admission into The University of Alabama's Graduate School
- B. Application and Acceptance into the Project PROMISE Scholar Program

Obligations

PROMISE Scholars must complete a full-time Master's Program, perform 700-1000 field hours in high-needs schools, an interdisciplinary course, a Capstone Project, and a professional development activity. Post-program, they are obligated to work two years per funding year as school-based mental health providers within seven years. Unmet obligations result in cash repayment.
