Research Agenda

I explore professional learning, interventions, instructional strategies, and teaching methods for elementary literacy. Specifically, my research emphasizes:

- a. Developing and implementing measures and professional learning to support pre-service and in-service teachers to instruct morphology;
- b. Creating interventions, curriculums, and instructional materials to support students' learning of morphology;
- c. Supporting teachers to embed disciplinary literacy skills in math, science, social studies, and cross-curricular reading;
- d. Preparing preservice teachers with the skills to teach literacy based on the science of reading;
- e. Mentoring literacy coaches to deliver professional development, form coaching partnerships, and foster self-efficacy for coaching.
