

Over 200,000 foundations in the U.S. provide grants, but only 10% have websites. That can make it difficult and time consuming to find new funding opportunities.

Access is provided via one computer terminal located on the 1st floor of Gorgas Library.



Essential Search Tools



- Global Search: search by phrase or list of key terms, such as your field of work or location, for a broad list of results
 - Foundations Directory does not recognize Boolean operators or the use of quotation marks
- Advanced Search: Search by specific criteria to *narrow* your results
 - Subject Area (what needs funding?)
 - Population Served (who will be affected by the funding?)
 - Location of grantmaker
 - Geographic Focus (where will funding be used?)
 - Organization Name
 - Who's Who (a person in an organization)
 - Organization Type
 - Support Strategy
 - Transaction Type

Reviewing your search results




Search results matching your criteria are shown in a list. Clicking **VIEW ALL** will show that list on a single page, making it easier to sort and filter.

REFINE your search results by clicking **EDIT** and updating your search terms

SORT your results by clicking on the header of any column to order the results alphabetically, – by location, or by other criteria you're interested in.




I. Select **Match All** or **Match Any**. This selection will add "And" or "Or" to the search rows beneath the option.

2. Click on the drop-down menu to select which field to search (All Fields, Abstract, Title, Sponsor, or Sponsor ID).

3. Choose **Funding Type** to limit to opportunities of a particular type or for a particular activity, such as research, conference, or travel grants.

4. Choose **Sponsor Type** to limit to opportunities from particular type of funder, such as the US or international governments, or a private foundation.

5. Choose **Sponsor Type** to limit to opportunities from a particular type of funder

Pivot utilizes a curated keywords index to classify funding opportunities. To increase the accuracy of your funding matches click on the keywords field and review the expanded option.

Search Tip: Some research topics may not get any results in searching, but that does not necessarily mean there are no grants for which your project may be eligible. If this happens, try searching for grants in the broader field(s) within which your project falls.



As you are looking at individual opportunities, select the "**see more opps like this**" (1) link. This is a quick way to get a list of opportunities closely related to the one you are looking. Choosing a **sponsor name (2)** will run a new search in Pivot and return results for all the opportunities that are available from that sponsor. You can also see new results based in the opp **keywords (3)**.



SAVING A SEARCH



Once you have a search with which you are satisfied, you may save it and receive updates via email each time a new grant opportunity matching your search is added to the database. No matter how many saved searches you have, you will only get one single weekly email that features results for each of your searches.


TRACKING A FUNDING OPPORTUNITY

There are two ways to track individual funding opportunities. The first is by selecting opportunities from your search results list, which will display options for tracking (1); the second is from within the individual opportunity (2). You will receive an email when there are updates to these opportunities.

Pivot also utilizes their keyword index to generate individual and departmental funding matches. The keywords in your profile also feed an automatic notification system called **advisor** (1). Faculty with Pivot profiles, receive notifications for personal funding matches based in their profile information (2).
