For successful completion of the gifted program, you must take and pass the following courses and examinations:

- □ SPE 581 Psychology of Gifted and Talented Children and Youth (typically offered fall semester)
- □ SPE 582 Teaching Gifted and Talented Students (typically offered spring semester)
- □ SPE 583 Creative Problem Solving (typically offered fall semester)
- □ SPE 584 Special Populations of Gifted and Talented (typically offered spring semester)
- □ SPE 585 Teaching Thinking Skills (typically offered summer semester)
- SPE 589 Internship in Gifted and Talented (typically offered fall and spring semesters; you will need one semester of internship); Note: All students are required to complete a total of 300 clock hours (ALSDE Admin Code 290-3-3-.44-Gifted)
