Employers rated 66% of EPP completers as

Teacher Leader/Effective Teacher on the
criterion: "...implement assessments in an
ethical manner and minimize bias to enable
learners to display the full extent of their
learning".

Employers rated **79%** of EPP completers as **Teacher Leader/Effective Teacher** on the criterion: "...**practice the profession in an ethical manner**".
